In addition to our service announcement # 6/2024 please find below an operational update:

## JE240240NB - Pia Express

As the Port of Tampa Bay remains closed for all navigation, while the port itself also continues to suffer from power outages and fuel shortages, mv Pia Express will continue to proceed to Panama City/FL.

The vessel will discharge all cargo in Panama City/FL as of October 12<sup>th</sup> 1000 hours It, and upon completion of cargo operations & bunkering return to Moin/Costa Rica.

## JE24041NB - Juice Express

Vessel is at present en-route towards Tampa, arriving at Tampa Bay pilot station by October 15<sup>th</sup> 0300 hours local time, weather permitting. Port of Tampa, USCG, and utility companies are working hard to reopen the port, and we are confident that Juice Express will be able to operate next week at the terminal of PLRS.

## JE24042NB – Pia Express

Pia Express will return to Puerto Moin for arrival October 17<sup>th</sup>. Vessel will then resume her usual schedule and call Tampa/Florida as port of discharge.
